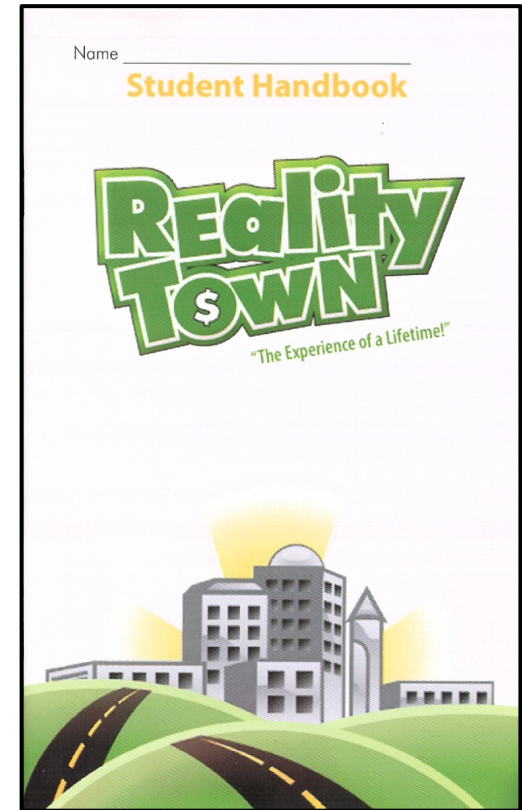

\*\*\*Concurrent Enrollment, Distance Learning, and Advanced Placement classes are strongly encouraged by the LHS Guidance Department if the student is prepared and willing to put in more time and energy to obtain a high grade. Choosing any of these options allow the student to receive college credit at a major discount. Some students graduate with a year of college done, and even a few graduate high school with an Associate's Degree. Most students take these classes in 11<sup>th</sup> and/or 12<sup>th</sup> grade, but some 10<sup>th</sup> grade students take these classes with counselor permission.
