




REALITY TOWN

Extended Year (Summer School) at Lehi High

- Dates are May 31- June 20 and June 21 July 13
- Must attend every day
- Cost is \$25 per quarter credit
- You may take up to 3 classes each block
- Fees paid at the Skyridge Financial Office
- Register through your Skyridge Counselor

Eastshore Online Program

- You can work anytime and at your own pace
- Cost is \$110 to enroll in the program and get your first packet
- Testing must be done at an Alpine School District High School
- Fees paid online at eastshorehs.com
- Check with your counselor to make sure you so the right packets

^{***}Concurrent Enrollment, Distance Learning, and Advanced Placement classes are strongly encouraged by the LIHS Guidance Department if the student is prepared and willing to put in more time and energy to obtain a high grade. Choosing any of these options allow the student to receive college credit at a major discount. Some students graduate with a year of college done, and even a few graduate high school with an Associate's Degree.

Most students take these classes in 11th and/or 12th grade, but some 10th grade students take these classes with counselor permission.



Pyramid of Excellence


