Meeting Notes:

- Reviewed Last Meeting Notes (11-14-18)
 - \$399 technology purchase was for an iPad and case
 - **Motion** to Approve Notes by Maria and seconded by Beverly was unanimously approved.
- Ideas for next year's plan
 - Maria put forth the idea of our system having fallen short in the area of training professionals and parents in gaining usable knowledge in the area of Transition. It would be good for teachers to know some of the other options in the areas of Transition after students are finished at ATEC.
 - Offer a checklist of the agencies that provide post-school services early on in the school year between the parent and teacher
 - Empowered Living
 - Turn
 - Having an open forum where transition agencies come and speak honestly about their organizations.
 - Are we getting our information in the area to parents effectively?
 - We could make a Yes/No Chart (If yes, do this; If no, do that) for parents to refer to
 - Speak with Debbie about discussing with parents the issue of Voc. Rehab. not being able to assist everyone and having some students move on from Voc. Rehab. to a private organization.
 - Enrichment in the school library so teachers can practice on them, rather than relying only on UATT
 - Technology programs that can reach all students
 - Augmented communication boards
 - Go Talk
 - Apps that can be downloaded onto all devices
 - Summer Collaboration
 - Classroom Aide
 - Library License renewal - The school could cover this with general funds
 - Library Books/Technology - The school could cover this with general funds as well
- Plan Update for this year
 - Classroom Aid is costing more than we had set aside - John is working to make sure we don't go over.
 - Equipment - \$429 budgeted and \$399 spent (iPad and case)
 - Computer Software - Spent the entire \$299 and \$30 more was spent (to be taken from the equipment fund)
 - Library Books Fund - Extra money to go to the Classroom Aid.
 - We had over \$1000 left over from last year's budget and we'll use that for the Classroom Aid as well.
- **Motion** to adjourn by Maria was seconded by Beverly and unanimously approved.
