SUBJECT: Skyridge High School Boundaries

On Tuesday, October 13, 2015, the Alpine District School Board of Education determined that the boundaries for Lehi High and Skyridge High Schools will be <u>closed</u> for the 2016-17 school year. The Board decided that current Lehi High juniors (class of 2017) will have the opportunity to choose to remain at Lehi High. Members of the class of 2017 who wish to remain at Lehi High MUST make their request by submitting a Senior Request To Attend Lehi High School form to the Counseling Center by Tuesday, December 1, 2015. All other students who live in Skyridge boundaries will AUTOMATICALLY be enrolled at Skyridge for the 2016-2017 school year.

Limited exceptions apply to students who are currently attending Lehi High and live within Skyridge boundaries.

- A current sophomore student attending Lehi High who has a sibling who is currently a junior at LHS and who has elected to remain at LHS may be granted an exception to remain at LHS (consecutive year siblings.)
- There could be additional special circumstances that would necessitate an exception. These exceptions will be evaluated by district administration.

UHSAA rules for athletic eligibility will apply. All current freshman or sophomore students in Skyridge boundaries who have established athletic eligibility at Lehi High (unless a special circumstances exception is granted) will be enrolled at Skyridge and their athletic eligibility will be transferred to Skyridge.
