Angela welcomed the group to the March meeting. A special recognition to Board Member, Paula Hill was presented. The meeting from the February meeting were read and approved.

Crisis Plan Presentation

- The outcome from the faculty and staff survey was presented. It is recognized that we need to train the teachers better, update the handbook, and determine a clear escape route.
- If a crisis happens in passing time or at lunch, students will report to the last class attended—this was unclear in the survey and needs to be addressed so students and faculty know this detail.
- Students need to be educated and aware of our Crisis Plan. An idea to make this happen would be through the TV/Video class making a video that all students would watch at the beginning of each year.
- The LDS Stake Center/Vista Heights Middle School is where we would evacuate to out the back. If we need to evacuate through the front, we would go to the transportation office/bus garage.

Hiring Update

- Have currently hired and secured five interns. Two more should be secured within 2-3 days.
- We will start interviewing full-time employees with a week.

Sex Trafficking

- There is an app where girls can sign up for a modeling appearance—it is called SA.
- This is a scam and everyone needs to be aware!
- Vista Heights Middle School is hosting Jay McFarland on March 15th at 7pm. He will review internet safety.

 - o Goal #2: ACT Improvement--\$14,000
 - o Goal #3: Improve SAGE and AP scores/Student Learning Outcome (SLO's)
 - Professional Development/Summer Collaboration--\$42,000
 - Computer Lab (mobile) & projectors--\$68,000
 - o If extra funds are given, they would be put toward professional development.
